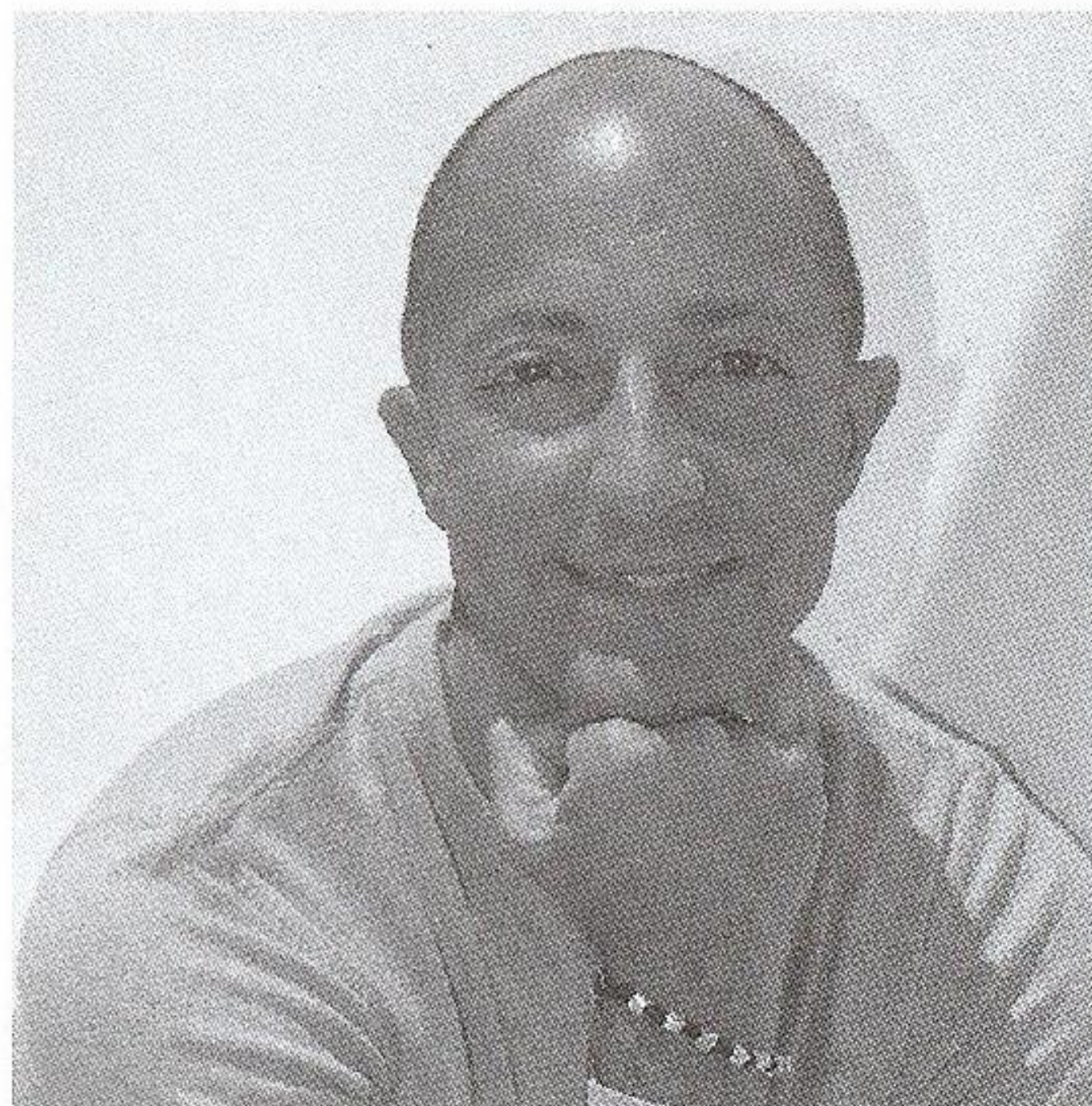


## AUCTIONEER

### Tax Deductibility

Donations are tax deductible to the extent allowed by law. You can deduct the amount of auction items purchased if they are greater than the retail value of the goods or services you receive. The retail value is provided by the donor and the ISPA Foundation makes no representation or warranty with respect to the retail value of the auction items as established by the donors. All tax-related questions should be referred to your personal tax advisor.

## Auction Details

- The donor has determined values set forth on items and has provided all descriptions. All items are sold "as is."
- Starting bids are set at a minimum of 20 percent of the retail value of all items.
- All bids must be written on bid slips. The bidder must identify his/her name and company name as they appear on his/her badge, and the amount of the bid.
- Bidding on an item authorizes the ISPA Foundation to release your contact information to the donor of the item on which you bid.
- Certificates must be used as indicated and copies are available for review at the Silent & Live Auction display. These certificates indicate any special black-outs or restrictions. We have tried to include all restrictions and blackout dates in the catalog information; however, we encourage you to review the certificate before bidding on any item that involves a certificate.
- Illegible entries will be disqualified.
- Bids are accepted in whole \$10USD increments only. Any bid that is not made in \$10 increments will be rounded up to meet this policy.
- A shipping center will be located in the Auction Room in Ballroom G for the shipment of the auction item(s) to the high bidder's destination of choice. The cost of shipping is the responsibility of the buyer.
- All bidding will close on Tuesday, Oct. 6, at 7 p.m. at the conclusion of the Live Auction.

### Payment

- A list of high bidders will be posted in the Auction Room in the Austin Convention Center – Level 4 – Ballroom G and outside the Professional Development Room at the Hilton Hotel.
- The payment center will open on Wednesday, Oct. 7, from 8 a.m. until 6 p.m. and Thursday, Oct. 8, from 8 a.m. until 1 p.m. High bidders can pick up their items and arrange for payment at this location.
- Bid sales are final - no exchanges or refunds.
- Items must be paid for in U.S. funds by cash, check, VISA, MasterCard, Discover or American Express.
- Items not picked up during Conference will be subject to a \$30 handling fee, in addition to shipping charges.
- Tax information will be provided to all donors and high bidders.
